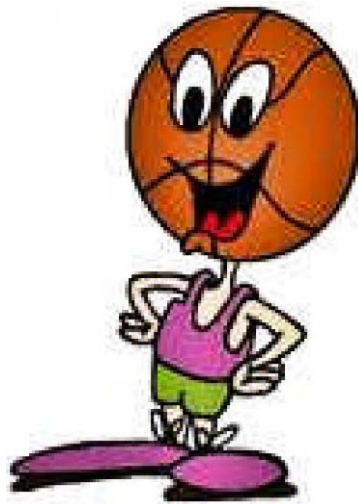


# **5A SIC BOYS BASKETBALL**



## **2009-2010 SEASON SUMMARY**

February 26, 2010

I would like to thank the 5A Southern Idaho Conference Boys Basketball teams for another exceptional year of competition. This year the name of the game was "defense." Opponents were held to 45 or fewer points 47% of the time. The winning team scored less than 50 points in 18 games, while reaching the 80-point mark only twice, one of those being the 85-83 double-overtime thriller between Eagle and Vallivue. Only two years ago the century mark was reached six times. How the pendulum swings.

While the team scoring was low, the individual scoring was not. Six players combined to score 30 or more points 8 different times. Craig Spjute, of Borah, led the way with games of 35, 33, and 36. Tyson Percifield, of Mountain View, had the season's high with 42 points - only three shy of the league's all-time best. Tyson also had a three-game stretch in which he connected on 27 of 28 free throws (96.4%). Jameson Shaw, of Eagle, had a blistering three-game streak in which he shot 85% (34/40) from the field including a 33 point game. Oh, did I mention that during that streak he shot 11/11 in one game?

One all-time SIC record was broken and a new one was added. There were also six additions to the 27-year records. Be sure to check them out.

# TWENTY-SEVEN YEARS OF SIC CONFERENCE HISTORY

The original SIC included Boise, Caldwell, Idaho Falls, Nampa, Twin Falls, and Pocatello. It grew to include Borah, Highland, Minico and Skyline. Eventually, the eastern schools left the conference to form their own league. Evidence of their membership still exists in the All-Time League Records.

**ORIGINAL MEMBERS IN 1983: Boise, Borah, Caldwell, Capital, Meridian, Mountain Home, and Nampa**

**1987: Centennial** joined raising the team total to 8.

**1993: Mountain Home** left lowering the team total back to 7.

**1995: Eagle** and **Mountain Home** joined making the team total 9.

**1997: Skyview** joined raising the total to 10.

**1998: MAJOR CHANGE — Timberline, Emmett, and Vallivue** joined creating a 13-team conference.

To accommodate, the league was divided into a **METRO DIVISION** which included **Boise, Borah, Capital, Centennial, Eagle, Meridian, and Timberline** and a **VALLEY DIVISION** which included **Caldwell, Emmett, Mountain Home, Nampa, Skyview, and Vallivue**. Each division would play teams in its own division on a home-and-home basis, and each team in the other division once. Each division had its own **SUB-DISTRICT** tournament which then sent the top four teams to the **DISTRICT** tournament. This format lasted two years.

**2000: MAJOR CHANGE —** The **VALLEY DIVISION** teams left the league. The league was back to 7.

**2002: Skyview** and **Nampa** rejoined the league giving it 9 teams.

**2003: MAJOR CHANGE — Mountain View** joined raising the team total to 10.

The league was divided into two **PODS, A** and **B**. **POD A** included **Boise, Capital, Eagle, Meridian, and Nampa**. **POD B** included **Borah, Centennial, Mountain View, Skyview, and Timberline**. As with the Division system of 1998, teams would play each team in their Pod on a home-and-home basis and the teams in the other Pod only once. There was no sub-district tournament.

**2004: MAJOR CHANGE —** The Pod system only lasted one year. **Nampa** and **Skyview** left the league, leaving only the 8 Boise and Meridian teams. The league returned to a single Division league.

**2006: Caldwell** and **Vallivue** joined the league raising the number of teams to 10.

**2008: Rocky Mountain** joined the league raising the number of teams to 11.

**As one can see, the SIC Conference has been in a state of continual flux for the last 20 years. What the future will hold is anyone's guess. The one thing that has remained constant is the high level of competition.**
