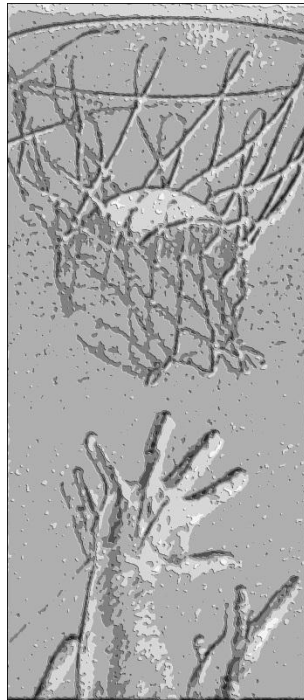


5A SIC BOYS BASKETBALL



2010-2011 SEASON SUMMARY

February 20, 2011

I would like to thank the 5A Southern Idaho Conference Boys Basketball teams for another exceptional year of competition. Close games and great free-throw shooting characterized this year. Of the 198 games played, 76% were decided by ten or fewer points. The winning margin was over 20 points in only 16 games. The fans were treated to a very exciting season.

Free-throw shooting contributed to the competitiveness of the games. Three teams shot over 70% in conference action. Centennial sizzled in one game hitting 20 of 21 for over 95%. Mountain View was not far behind shooting 87% on 27 of 31. Five players shot over 75% for the season. Faruk Huskic of Centennial had an individual streak of six games in which he hit 32 of 34 free-throws for 94%. Tyson Percifield of Mountain View shot 38 of 40 over five games for 95%. The league came very close to matching the all-time free-throw percentage records for both season and conference.

Tyson Percifield passed the magic 1000-point mark in his career scoring for Mountain View. In four seasons, he scored 1154 points during the regular season and 1036 points in conference. If tournament games were included, he would have well over 1400 points by the end of the State Tournament.

One all-time SIC record was broken this year and there were seven players added to the 28-year records. Be sure to check them out.

I would like to thank Bill Bogan for again making the SIC stats accessible to family and friends on his fine website, idahoops.com. He does an outstanding job!

Vince Hordemann continues to use our stats in his Idaho Select Basketball newsletter at idahoselect.com. Thank you for the continued exposure you have given our league.

Thanks, also, to Jessie Zentz of the Idaho Statesman and to Bruce Mason of the *Idaho Press Tribune* for their support of high school athletics. Their support is truly appreciated.

Most importantly, I would like to thank the players in our league who spend the many hours practicing each week. Whether their teams win or lose, their dedication to the sport is commendable. Thank you for the thrills and excitement you gave us this year, all 134 of you.

Lastly, I would like to thank the coaches for the time and effort they put into getting their team stats to me each week. They are a class act! It is their timeliness that makes the Weekly Reports meaningful. Thanks to them, I was able to compile and send out the reports like clockwork each Monday evening.

Good luck to the teams that are continuing on to the State Tournament. And may all of you have a super 2011-2012 season!

SOMETHING NEW HAS BEEN ADDED

Several new stats can be found in this year's summary. The section "Shooting Percentages Allowed" shows the defensive percentages for total field goals, three-point goals, and free throws. Free throws cannot actually be defended, but the category will show the degree to which they affected each team's season.

Similarly, "Rebounds Allowed" shows the number of offensive, defensive, and total rebounds pulled down by the opposition. A new stat, the "Rebound Margin" (RBM), is determined by subtracting the total opponent rebounds from a team's total and then dividing by the number of games played. The result is a per-game rebound margin. Note the asterisks beside some of the teams in this category in the season stats section. These teams have higher RBM's than they should have because they did not have any nonconference opponent rebounds reported. For the same reason, their defensive shooting percentages are the same for the season as they are for the conference.

Some coaches include the opposing team's stats in their game summaries and others do not. To make the data fair, the shooting and rebounding stats for each opponent were pulled from that opponent's own game summary and compiled with all of the other opponents' stats. One interesting observation is that the total league rebounds for the two categories do not match. They are, in fact, the same rebounds observed from two different viewpoints. Indeed, this is not an exact science!

The last new stat is the "Assist to Turnover Ratio" (SATR and CATR). It was suggested that this might be a better stat to use than the "CCMP" or the "SCMP." Both will be used for the present.

It is hoped that these new stats will be beneficial to the league. The Weekly Reports need to remain relatively brief, but if you would like to see any of these new stats included next year, please let me know. Likewise, let me know if there is any additional stat that you think would be useful to add.

TWENTY-EIGHT YEARS OF SIC CONFERENCE HISTORY

The Big Six, which included Boise, Caldwell, Idaho Falls, Nampa, Twin Falls, and Pocatello, was the big school league in Southern Idaho until the fall of 1958. That is when Borah joined and the league and it changed its name to the Southern Idaho Conference (SIC). It grew to include Highland, Capital, Minico, Skyline, Mountain Home, and Meridian. The SIC split into Eastern and Western divisions during the 1970's. Eventually, the Eastern schools left the conference to form their own league. Evidence of their membership still exists in the All-Time Conference Records. I have been researching the early years and hope to include a complete list of league champions, W/L records, head coaches, and team members from 1959 to the present in next year's summary.

The SIC membership of **1983** included Boise, Borah, Caldwell, Capital, Meridian, Mountain Home, and Nampa.

1987: Centennial joined raising the membership to 8.

1993: Mountain Home left lowering the membership back to 7.

1995: Eagle and Mountain Home joined raising the membership to 9.

1997: Skyview joined raising the total to 10.

1998 – MAJOR CHANGE – Timberline, Emmett, and Vallivue joined creating a 13-team conference. To accommodate, the conference was divided into a Metro Division which included Boise, Borah, Capital, Centennial, Eagle, Meridian, and Timberline and a Valley Division which included Caldwell, Emmett, Mountain Home, Nampa, Skyview, and Vallivue. Each division played teams in its own division on a home-and-home basis and each team in the other division once. Each division held its own Sub-District tournament. The top four teams from each Sub-District tournaments then went to the District tournament. This format lasted two years.

2000 – MAJOR CHANGE – The Valley Division teams left the conference lowering its membership to 7.

2002: Skyview and Nampa re-joined the conference raising the total to 9.

2003 – MAJOR CHANGE – Mountain View joined raising the team total to 10. The conference was again divided. This time the divisions were called Pods. Pod A included Boise, Capital, Eagle, Meridian, and Nampa. Pod B included Borah, Centennial, Mountain View, Skyview, and Timberline. Teams would play each member of their pod on a home-and-home basis and the teams in the other pod only once. There was no sub-district tournament.

2004 – MAJOR CHANGE – The pod system only lasted one year. Nampa and Skyview left the conference, leaving only the eight Boise and Meridian teams. The conference returned to a single division league.

2006: Caldwell and Vallivue joined the conference raising the membership to 10.

2008: Rocky Mountain joined the conference raising the membership to 11 where it remains today.

As one can see, the SIC has been in a state of continual flux for the last 21 years. What the future will hold is anyone's guess. The one thing that has remained constant is the level of high competition.
